Privacy Policy for Pi Day Challenge

Pi Day Challenge ("we," "us," or "our") operates www.pidaychallenge.com (the "Site"). We are committed to protecting your privacy and ensuring transparency in how we collect, use, and safeguard your personal information. This Privacy Policy outlines our practices in compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA), and the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA).

1. Information We Collect

We collect only the following personal information:

- Email Address: This is used to allow users to save their progress and resume the challenge later.
- Username (Optional): Users can create a display name for the leaderboard.

We do not collect any other personally identifiable information.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use your email address solely to:

- Enable you to save and retrieve your progress on the Pi Day Challenge.
- Provide customer support if you experience issues with progress restoration.

We **do not** sell, share, or distribute email addresses to third parties.

3. FERPA Compliance

If an educational institution registers students for the Pi Day Challenge, we handle student information in compliance with FERPA. We do not disclose or share student data except as authorized by the institution or as required by law.

4. COPPA Compliance

We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13 without parental consent. If we become aware that we have collected such information without appropriate consent, we will delete it promptly.
